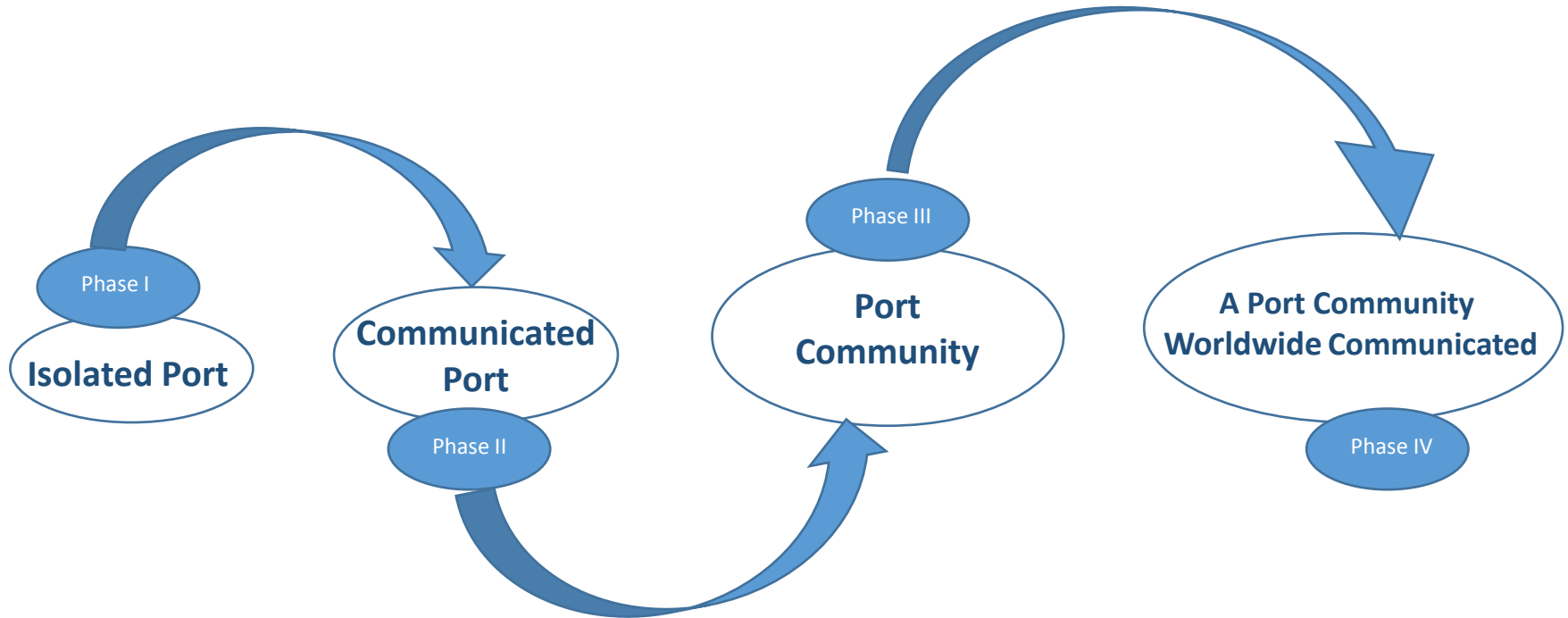

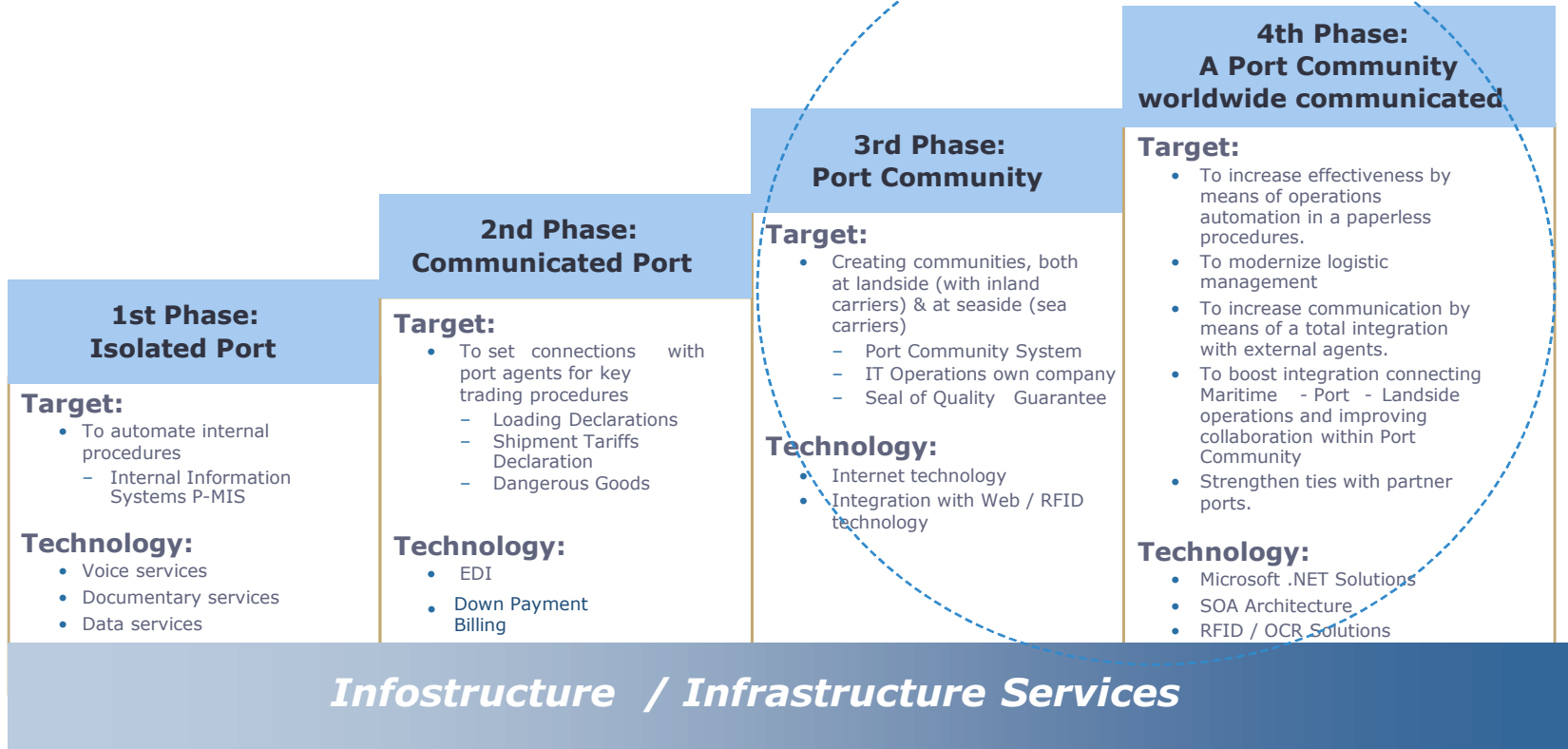

The Four(4) Phases of Port Development





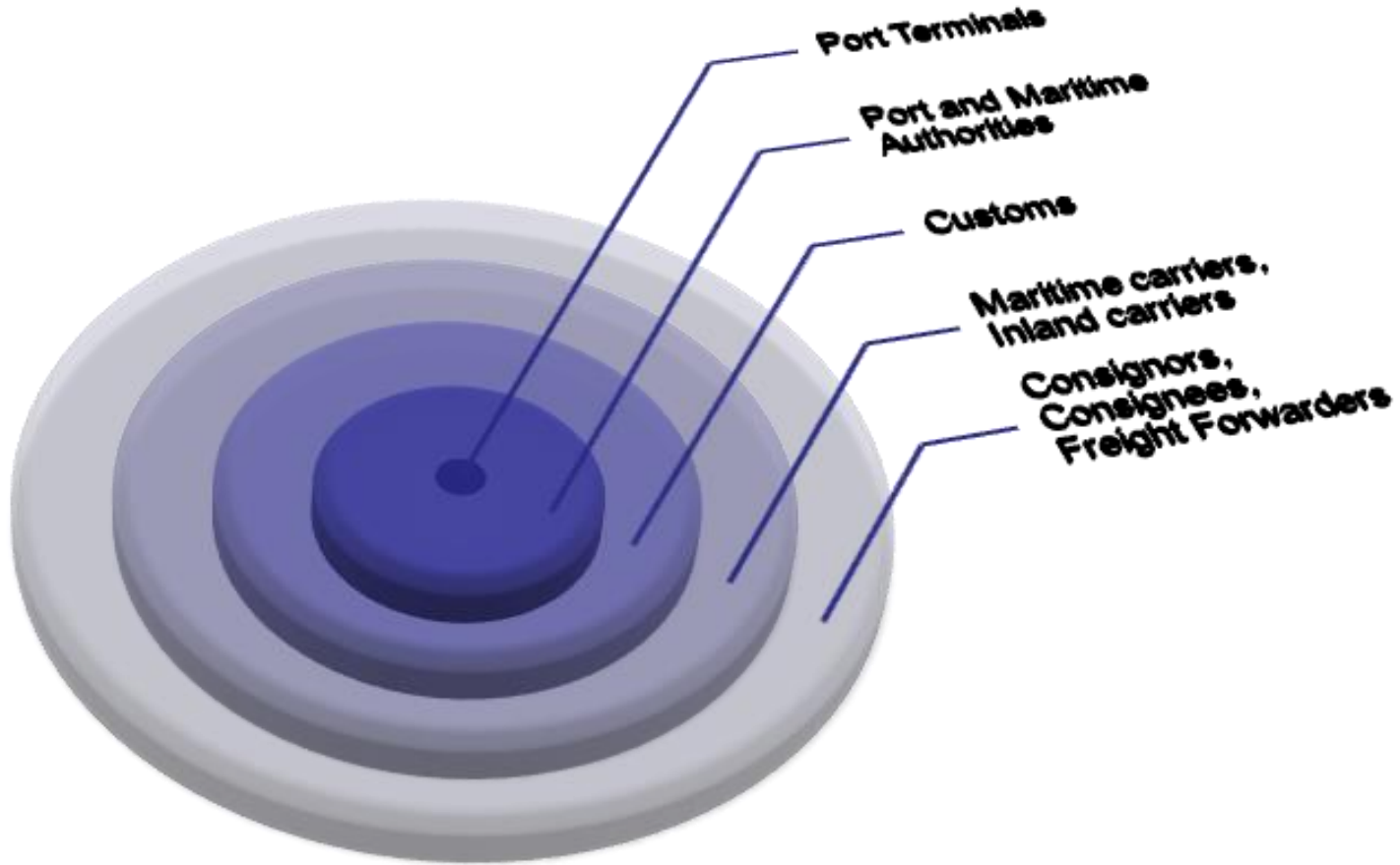

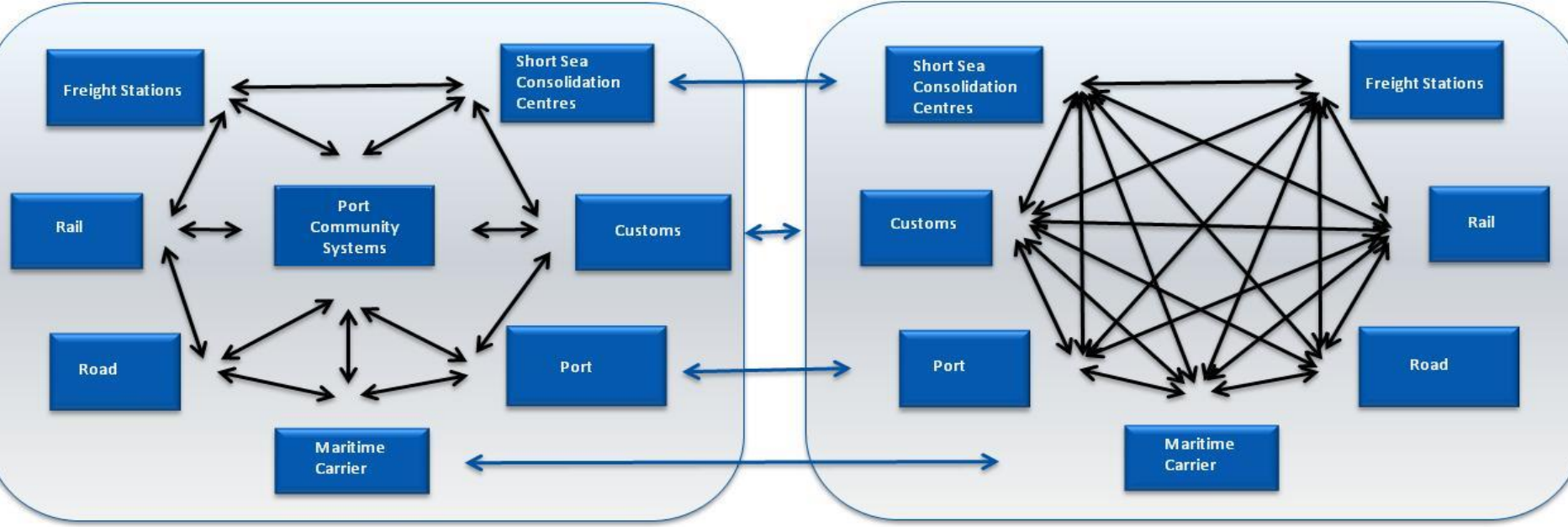

Sends the application via the portal of ABC and follows the prepayment procedures using eBanking

A Receiving Email will be sent by the ABC Web Server to applicant

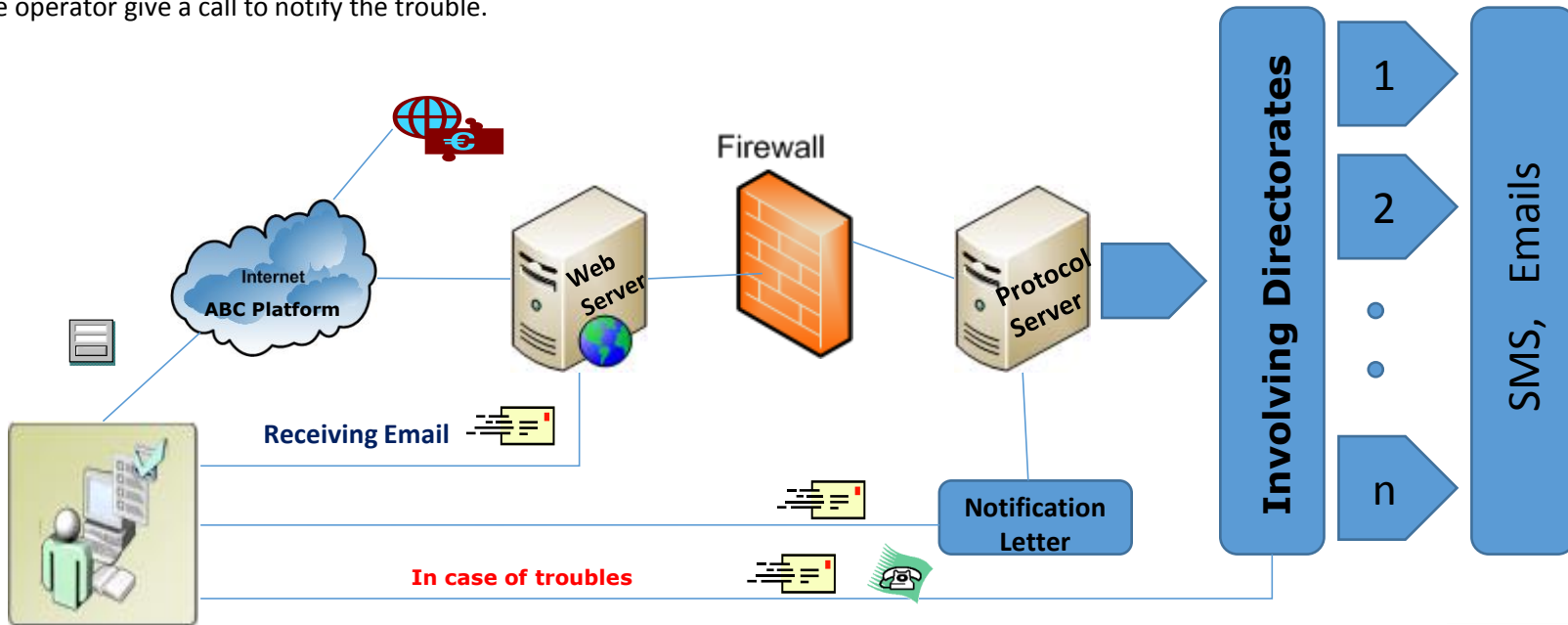
The web server sends the application to the Protocol Server

Protocol server sends the application to respective directorates and

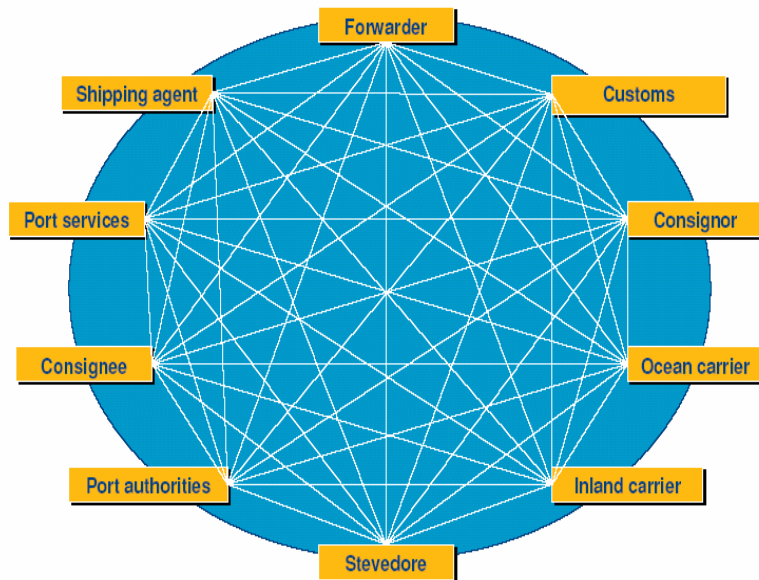
simultaneously Email and SMS to the operators of the application.

Protocol server sends Notification letter to applicant and SMS if requested by the sender

In case of troubles in the applications the system sends a troubling Email and the operator give a call to notify the trouble.

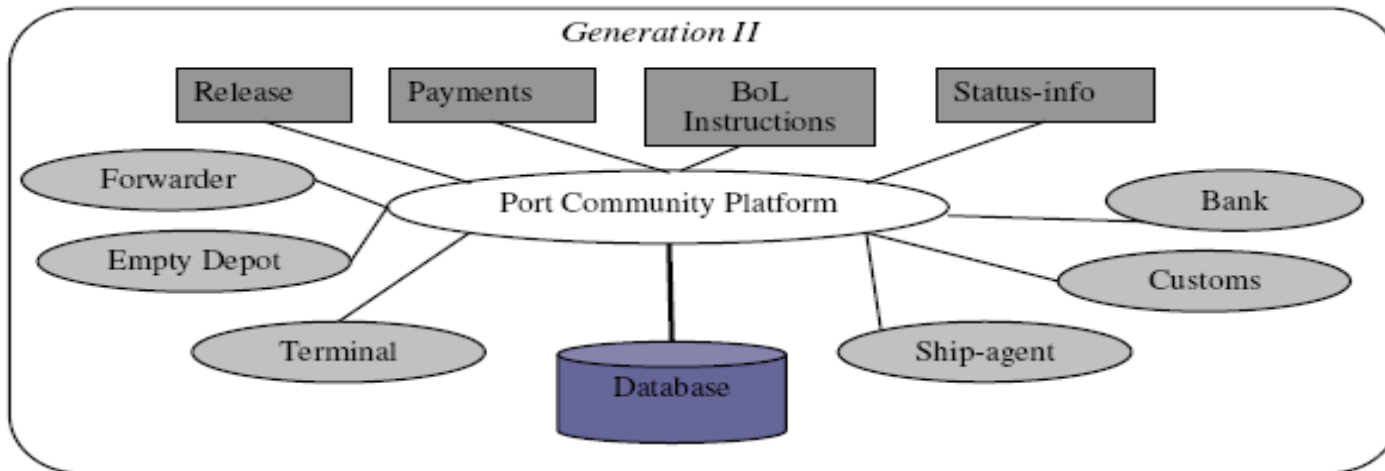
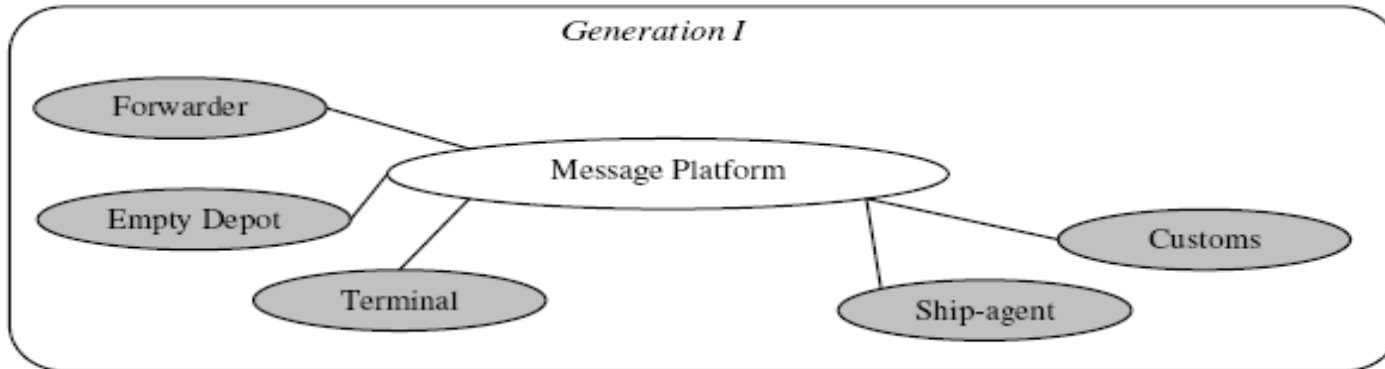
